Stalking, Relationship Abuse and Coercive Control

**A 2-hour session including identifying risks, signposting
and safety planning**

This training course aims to give you the tools and confidence to recognise stalking, relationship abuse and coercive control. It will allow you to spot signs and the confidence to intervene and support students and young people. You will hear about what stalking is and how it can impact lives by listening to Alice's story. Following the course, you will have access to resources to use in class and signposting to professional support services.
